DETAILS

Adelaida has 5 organically-farmed vineyards in the coastal influenced Santa Lucia Mountain Range on the west side of the Paso Robles AVA. Situated on steep hillsides, these sites lie within the Adelaida District, a sub-appellation in the northwest corner of the wine region. With elevations ranging from (1400 - 2050 ft), limestone subsoils, and extreme diurnal temperature swings, averaging 45 degrees, Adelaida produces wines with distinct expressions of their site.

Our 'Paso Robles' designation combines predominately Adelaida Estate grapes from the steep Viking Vineyard plus select fruit from neighboring sites, all within the Adelaida District AVA. Always showing its Cabernet Sauvignon pedigree, the wine delivers a Bordeaux-like statement due to its final blending with Cabernet Franc.

Delivering the brilliantly deep ruby hued spectrum we expect from this varietal; such a luster paves the way for further discovery. Sense of place and varietal characteristics deliver the goods through Adelaida Dust, along with blackcurrant and plum compote. Adelaida rocks, Cacao nibs, freshly turned soil, and fine French oak barrels all live in harmony to create this classic bouquet. The wine shows freshness, purity, and structure through flavors of plum, baking spices, and fine toasted barrels. Beautiful and richly flavored with a velvety texture and a milk chocolate finish. A wine of charm with substance. Drink now through 2024.
