

## ROUSSANNE 2004 Tablas Creek Vineyard

From the neighboring Estate of Tablas Creek, this one time only limited bottling is a rarely shared resource of "true wood" vines originating from Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France. This "Beaucastel" transplant now reveals its Paso personality by clearly translating classic varietal aromatics of pear and almond through the brilliant limestone minerality of Westside Paso. The rich weighty mouth-feel is enlivened by a vibrant acid structure that allows the wine to show well now and for the next few years.
