Adelaida's organically-farmed estate vineyards are located in the coastal influenced Santa Lucia Mountain Range on the west side of the Paso Robles AVA. Situated on steep hillsides, these sites lie within the Adelaida District, a sub-appellation in the northwest corner of the wine region. With elevations ranging from 1400 - 2050 ft, limestone subsoils, and extreme diurnal temperature swings, averaging 45 degrees, Adelaida produces wines with distinct expressions of their site.

Adelaida Vineyards received about 12.5 inches of rain in the 2019-2020 winter, accounting for only half of the historical average. This limited rainfall, combined with notably higher-than-average heat and significant fires in Northern California, led to an arduous year of grape production. On a positive note, we attribute our above-average yields on our transition to organic practices in the vineyards, even with the challenges of 2020.

A relatively rare grape in California, Adelaida has only produced three vintages of Cinsaut: 2010, 2012, and 2020. More often used as a blending grape, this vintage showcases its ability to stand alone, showing bright raspberry and red currant backed by a complex mix of black tea and violet. The wine is supple on the palate but has elevated tannins and is suited to a wide variety of cuisine. Enjoy chilled through 2028.
