Adelaida has 5 organically-farmed vineyards in the coastal influenced Santa Lucia Mountain Range on the west side of the Paso Robles AVA. Situated on steep hillsides, these sites lie within the *Adelaida District*, a sub-appellation in the northwest corner of the wine region. With elevations ranging from 1400 - 2050 ft, limestone subsoils, and extreme diurnal temperature swings, averaging 45 degrees, Adelaida produces wines with distinct expressions of their site.

A unique varietal in the landscape of Paso Robles wines; it's strikingly aromatic and brings to mind violets in the pine forest, bay laurel and bergamot. It also displays distinctive, juicy and vibrant flavors that make the varietal a coveted wine among sommeliers, with tastes reminiscent of blueberry, black licorice, plum and mint flavors keep pumping on this robust and fascinating wine.
