Adelaida's organically-farmed estate vineyards are located in the coastal-influenced Santa Lucia Mountain Range on the west side of the Paso Robles AVA. Situated on steep hillsides, these sites lie within the Adelaida District, a sub-appellation in the northwest corner of the wine region. With elevations ranging from 1400 - 2050 ft, limestone subsoils, and extreme diurnal temperature swings, averaging 45 degrees, Adelaida produces wines with distinct expressions of their site.

Now in its third decade, our Anna's Vineyard has matured and is producing topquality fruit. This meticulously researched planting was developed using random block design in affiliation with Cal Poly as a real-world classroom. The site was at the forefront of incorporating ENTAV clonal material and lime-tolerant rootstocks. These now mature vines vividly translate the site and varietal purity.

The 2021 vintage joins the fantastic trio of Roussane, Grenache blanc, and Picpoul blanc to create a well-rounded white wine with exciting aromatics and a clean yet full mouthfeel. The initial aromas of honeysuckle and freshly baked bread jump out of the glass, hinting at a full-bodied white wine. The palate shows a different side with clean and bright flavors of green apple and lemon zest. This wine accentuates the nuances that each grape varietal brings to the table. Enjoy chilled through 2024.
