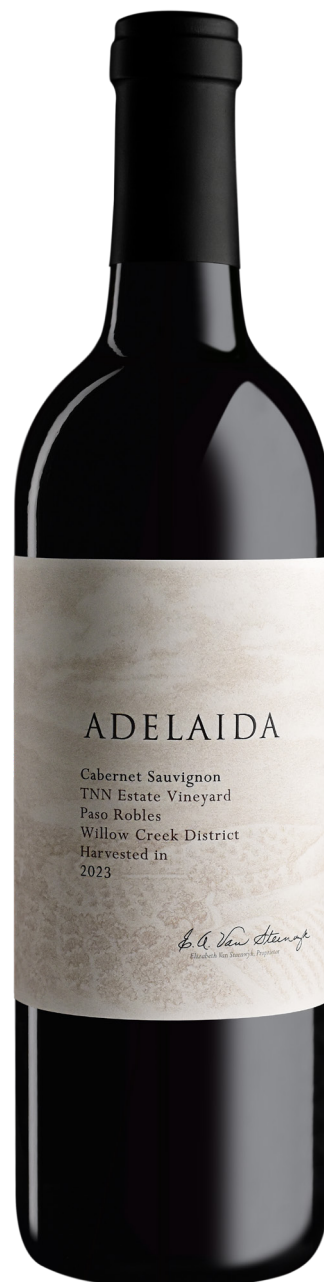

Adelaida's organically farmed estate vineyards are located in the coastal-influenced Santa Lucia Mountain Range on the west side of the Paso Robles AVA. With elevations ranging from 1400 - 2050 ft, limestone subsoils, and extreme diurnal temperature swings, averaging 45 degrees, Adelaida produces wines with distinct expressions of their site.

The 2023 growing season at Adelaida was the longest and coolest in 12 years. We received 30.66" of rainfall—10 inches more than in the 2022 growing season—and did not see even a single day hit 100F (although we came close on July 15, when it hit 99.77F). We began picking on September 5. August and September were especially cool, and there were many points when we worried that ripening might not occur before the rains came. Fortunately, October days were nice and warm, and the rains did not begin until November 18, well after our final pick of the year on November 8.

In only its second vintage, the 2023 Signature Cabernet Sauvignon from Tir Na Nog vineyard is a true testament to power bound within our calcareous soils. The nose commands attention, unfurling with opulent Santa Rosa plum and luxurious crème de cassis, all grounded by cedarwood and petrichor. On the palate, a wave of intense black cherry leaps forward, seamlessly integrated with a vibrant lift of fresh mint, crushed shell, and a hint of warmed allspice. Enjoyable now, with the structure to cellar gracefully for 15 years or more.
